SeeSaw Class app for Students

REMOTE LEARNING

If you have the **SeeSaw class** app, the students can log in with their unique code that was already provided. If you don't have the app, you can access the class by going to <u>https://web.seesaw.me/</u> on the internet (e.g. using Chrome, Safari, Internet Explorer, Firefox) and clicking on 'Log In', click on 'I am a Student' and then enter your provided code (remember the spaces in the correct places!). Please note this code is a password to get access to the student's account. Therefore, please keep this code in a safe place and do not post such codes on social media or in any publicly accessible place on the Internet.

Google Meets

Google Meets will allow all students and classroom teachers to meet online to help connect with each other. Class teachers will advise the time of the Meets and the access codes via SeeSaw. Attached are the instructions of how to log into Google Meet.



ONLINE LEARNING TIPS

Thank you to all our families for your support during these unprecedented times of online learning. Managing our time and supporting our children is a real challenge and there isn't necessarily a right or wrong way of doing things. In order to manage our wellbeing during these times, here's 5 tips to help manage the technology side of you children's learning.

- **Tip 1: Supervision** We strongly encourage all children to use their devices in a shared space rather than being in a bedroom unsupervised.
- **Tip 2: Social Media** A reminder that most social media sites, such as Tik Tok, Snapchat, Facebook and Instagram have an age restriction of 13 years and over.
- **Tip 3: Clear expectations** Remember that you have the right to set restrictions in terms of screen time and to structure your day at home to suit your needs.
- **Tip 4: Screen Time** We strongly encourage all children to balance screen time with activities that don't involve a digital device. A ball game or reading a book are all great ways to show kids how they can learn and enjoy themselves without a mobile, tablet or computer and can help managing your day.
- **Tip 5: Charging Devices** make sure all devices are put away each night and are charged for learning the following day.

ZIPTALES

Ziptales is an online literacy library, created by teachers, to advance a love of reading. It covers all levels from Preschool through to Grade 6.

Ziptales is directly aligned to the Australian National Curriculum, and has been shown to improve children's love of reading, and to raise their skill levels. Its Reading Level Test can help recommend material that should provide your child with a 'comfortable' reading experience – not too simple, and not too challenging.
