Dear Families.

Welcome back to what will be a very different term – something that I have never encountered in my thirty-five years of education. These are very challenging times, but by supporting each other, we will get through to the other side. I believe that we will be more grateful for the smallest things – things that we may have gone without for so long.

I hope you all had a great Easter – again it would have been very different. No family gatherings, no picnics in parks, so very different. I was moved during the Easter Sunday Mass that was televised on television. The parents and sibling of four children who were killed by a drunk driver on February 1st this year were involved in this Mass. Mrs Leila Abdallah read one of the readings and Mrs Bridget Sakr and her son Michael assisted in the offertory procession. Mrs Abdallah lost 3 children in the accident and Mrs Sakr lost a daughter. Their strength at such a time of grief was an example of how we need to live our lives. They also spoke of how they have forgiven the driver who killed their children. I ask you to pray for the Abdallah and Sakr Families and keep them in your prayers.

We also remember the thousands of people that have died throughout the world due to COVID-19. Across the world there have been more than 1.9 million confirmed cases of COVID-19 and more than 119,000 deaths. We continue to pray for the families of those who have died and for those who are recovering from this virus.

I would like to thank you all for supporting us as we transition to online learning. We ask you to remember that you are not teaching the children. Your role is to supervise your children as they complete the activities that have been planned by the teachers. I appreciate that so many of you were very positive when you were contacted yesterday about how you were feeling about moving to online learning. These are very challenging times for all of us – but together we can do the best for your children.

I can confirm that the following events have been cancelled or postponed:

- Mother's Day Breakfast (May 5th) and the Mother's Day Stall (May 7th).
- Multicultural Day including the Special Lunch (May 8th).
- NAPLAN (May $12^{th} 22^{nd}$).

- Sacrament of Eucharist (Sunday May 24th)
- MMA Camp (June 1st and 2nd)

Once we have permission to have Masses, we will organise a new date for the Sacrament of Eucharist, as well as the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We also hope to be able to reschedule the MMA Camp, although this may not be possible. At this stage we hope to have the production in Term IV - at this stage we will need to push it back a few weeks. I will endeavor to keep you informed of these events as we find out more information.

I know your child's teacher will be in regular contact with you. However, if you have any questions, please email them and they will endeavor to get back to you as soon as possible. I would like to thank Ms Cathy Doran and the Leadership Team for all they did in the last week of term when the announcement was made that the term would finish early and teachers were to prepare for online learning. Thanks also to the teachers, office staff and all the Learning Support officers for the way they supported the Leadership Team. This was another great example of all staff working together for the benefit of the St Paul's School Community.

I pray that our God will be with all of you throughout these trying times.
