Welcome back to Term 4. As you would be aware remote learning will continue for the next two weeks. From Monday 18th October, there is a staggered return of students to class. Please note that the canteen will not be open until Monday 8th November.

Over the holidays, we were sad to hear of the passing of Beatriz Gonzalez, mother of Mrs Trish Morris, and Quan Thanh Nguyen, brother of Ms Lan Nguyen. Beatriz and Quan both died suddenly. I ask you to keep Lan and Trish and their families in your thoughts and prayers at this sad time. We extend our deepest condolences to both families.

Unfortunately, due to the lockdown continuing, we have had to cancel the MMA Camp to Phillip Island. If we are able to rebook the camp, we will. We will also have to postpone the Sacrament of Confirmation that was to be held on October 13th. Once a new date is provided to us, we will advise you all as soon as possible.

From Thursday, 7th October until Thursday 28th October, Staff, Students and Families are invited to take part in MACSSIS (Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools School Improvement Surveys). Families will receive an email containing log in details and a link to access the surveys online. When families log on, they will be able to choose the language in which to complete the survey. Your responses are highly valued as the information we receive from the survey helps to determine the future directions of the school. Students from Years 4 to 6 will complete the surveys with their class teachers, either online or at school. We appreciate the time you take to help improve our school!

Please note there will be a school closure day on Thursday 14th October as staff will be completing professional practice activities. There will be no supervision at school and no online activities posted by teachers.
