Dear Families,

Many of our Year 5 and 6 children will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation this Friday, 19th November commencing at 6.00pm and 7.30pm at St Paul's Church. The children have been very well prepared by Miss Peplow, Mrs Garcia, Miss Capuano, Mr Adam, Miss Jane, Mrs Kylie, Mr Fox and Miss Carroll. It will look very different at the Mass – all adults will be wearing masks, will be required to check in and show their vaccination certificate to staff. I ask you to continue to pray for the children as they make their final preparations to receive this Sacrament. Unfortunately, there are some children who will be unable to attend one of the Masses due to being in isolation. We will be organizing another date for them to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation before the end of the year.

We are starting to have our isolating classes returning to school. We look forward to have all children onsite. Please remember, any child who shows any symptoms of COVID-19 must not be sent to school and should be taken to have a COVID-19 test to ensure they are negative. I cannot stress how important this is as we want to keep ALL in our school community safe.

You will shortly receive a new account with a credit applied for the extra curricular activities that have been cancelled due to COVID-19 ie, excursions, swimming, camps and Sacraments. The amounts being credited per level are Prep - \$115, JMA - \$115, MMA - \$265, SMA - \$345. If you have paid your account fully in 2021, the amount credited will go towards your child's fees for 2022. If you have paid all fees and are leaving the school, you will receive a cheque to the value of the credit.

We had five transitions today for our 2022 Prep students. We have two more sessions on Wednesday 17th November at 9.00am and 10.00am. Prep Orientation will be held on Monday 22nd November at 9.15am until 10.15am. There will be an online information session for 2022 Prep Parents on Monday 22nd November at 7.00pm

Unfortunately, we have been forced to cancel our Carols Night this year. Each year level will provide a part of the Christmas story and sing Christmas Carols – these Advent Prayer Services will be recorded and uploaded to Seesaw for families to view.

We will be unable to celebrate our Year 6 Graduation at St Paul's Church this year due to restrictions of numbers at the church. As was the case last year, we will be recording the Graduation Ceremony on Monday 6th December and then making it available via a link for families to view it on Thursday 9th December at 7.00pm.


