<u>COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINIC - ST. PAUL'S SCHOOL – MONDAY 28TH AND TUESDAY</u> <u>29TH MARCH</u>

A COVID-19 vaccination clinic will be hosted at St Paul's School on Monday, March 28 and Tuesday, March 29. You are free to collect your child from school early and take them to the clinic or return later with your child. We will let you know what room in the school the clinic will be set up in shortly.

Expert clinical staff will be there to provide the Pfizer vaccine to children at the school and their families including parents, grandparents and younger siblings aged 5-11. We would love to see you there. The clinical staff are also happy to answer any questions you might have about vaccinations and they understand if you want more time to think about it and choose not to get vaccinated that day. Please note you will need to take your child to the clinic if you want them to receive the vaccination – the school will **NOT BE TAKING ANY CHILDREN TO THE CLINIC.** Please come along to the school and help keep our community safe.
