# GRADE 6 STUDENTS: APPLICATION FOR YEAR 7 PLACEMENT 2023 (GOVERNMENT SCHOOL)

#### CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSION FUND

Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund is Government Funding to assist families to cover the costs of school excursions, camps and sporting activities.
