Dear Parents/Carers.

This Wednesday we celebrate Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of Lent. Lent is a period of preparation for Easter and lasts for forty days. We remember how Jesus spent forty days in the desert praying and fasting. Lent is a time for us to come to know Jesus more closely. People often think of Lent as a time for giving things up, but perhaps this year we can think of Lent as a time to show Love and learn more about the Love Jesus Christ has for us and how we can live out the St. Paul's Core Values - Respect, Diversity, Learning and Care and Compassion. I encourage families to contribute to Project Compassion during the Season of Lent. I hope you can join us this Wednesday for our Ash Wednesday Mass. It will commence at 10.00am and will be held at St. Paul's Church. All children will be walking to the church. FEES/LEVIES

ANAPHYLAXIS

There are several children at school who suffer from allergic reactions to various forms of food, plants, bites and stings. The Australian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy (ASCIA) does not recommend the banning of particular items. This is based on the premise that for school age children, an essential step is to develop strategies for avoidance in the wider community as well as at school. All staff have undertaken anaphylactic training and will have it renewed this term. The school has a thorough policy, action plan and procedures for each child, including first aid response and medication storage, to ensure the wellbeing of all students. BEFORE SCHOOL CARE

The yard is supervised from 8.25am every morning. Parents are asked not to send their children to school before this time. Class teachers are at school but they are unable to supervise children because they will be preparing for the day's activities. Before School Care Program operates every morning. FOOTBALL

Confirmation to attend a trial will occur before the end of Term 1, 2024. Once registered, the parent will receive an email confirming payment and a form which will require the Principal's signature.

Our Educators are on site between 7:00am - 9:00am each morning, so please pop by or give us a call!

If you register your child for the service and they have any medical needs (ADHD, ASD, Asthma, Anaphylaxis, Allergies etc.) all Medical Managent Plan documents and your child's medication need to be completed and provided prior to your child attending their firest session. This is to ensure your

child's safety, we will be unable to accept your child into care if their Medical Management Plans or their Medications are expired.

If your child/children will be attending the After school Care program please ensure they know to come as its very important for children to arrive safely at the service. If your child/children has a booking and will not be attending due to a change in circumstances, please inform the Coordinator on 0401362738. This can be done via phone call, or text message. If your circumstances do change, please ensure you also make the school aware.

Prep 2024 Students! Each year, we follow a prep process to ensure continuity between our routines and the school. In Before School Care, our educators will help transition preps by taking them to their prep line or classroom. In After School Care, our educators will collect preps from their classroom line or the classroom, then bring them straight to our OSHC room.
