**15th August 2025:** Applications close for 2027 Year 7 students in Catholic Secondary Colleges – our current Year 5 Students

17<sup>th</sup> October 2025: Offers posted to prospective 2027 Year 7 applicants
7<sup>th</sup> November 2025: Final date for families to accept offers made by the Secondary School
