MODIFIED OR PETROL POWERED BICYCLES



MOTORBIKES

- To ride on or off-road it must be registered with a full or recreation registration
- Helmet must be worn at all times



- 25 km/h MAX speed
- Motor cannot provide power at speeds nigher than 25km/h
- net must be worn at all times
- No passengers Cannot be ridden on footpaths



E-SCOOTER

- Be aged 16 yrs or over Max speed 20 kmph
