## MATHEMATICS REPORTING

Dear Parents,

In 2025 all Catholic schools must fully implement the revised Victorian Mathematics Curriculum 2.0. The Mathematics Version 2.0 curriculum includes changes to the achievement standards used by teachers to assess and report student learning from Foundation (Prep) to Year 10.

In the past students have received three scores under the strands Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry, Statistics and Probability.

Under the Mathematics Version 2.0 curriculum, teachers will report against the achievement standard as a whole, providing a single, aggregated score based on assessments on all six strands: Number, Algebra, Measurement, Geometry, Statistics and Probability.

Using the learning evidence against the strands taught across the reporting cycle each semester, teachers make an on-balance and holistic judgement with reference to achievement standards that accurately reflects where the student is on the learning continuum for Mathematics Version 2.0.



## **IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2025**

The following dates are very important for <u>ALL</u> students who will be attending secondary school in 2027 – our current Year 5 students. If applications for Catholic Secondary School are not in by Friday 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 your child will not be enrolled in your school of choice.

15<sup>th</sup> August 2025: Applications close for 2027 Year 7 students in Catholic Secondary Colleges – our current Year 5 Students 17<sup>th</sup> October 2025: Offers posted to prospective 2027 Year 7 applicants

7<sup>th</sup> November 2025: Final date for families to accept offers made by the Secondary School

## CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSION FUND (CSEF)

Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund is Government Funding to assist families to cover the costs of school excursions, camps and sporting activities. Centrelink health care card holders and Pensioner Concession card holders may be eligible for a payment of \$154. If you think you qualify for the CSEF, please contact the office for a form. Please complete and return the CSEF form to school, along with a copy of your Centrelink Card. It is important that you submit this CSEF form to be assessed for the school bonus of \$400 per child at Catholic schools. Therefore, please submit the CSEF form ASAP.
