#### Dear Parents/Carers,

In 2025, National Child Protection Week (NCPW) will be celebrated from September 7<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup>. NCPW will continue to embrace the overarching message that 'Every child, in every community, needs a fair go'. This year's theme – 'Every conversation matters: Shifting conversation to action' – highlights that, while discussions are crucial, dialogue must translate to meaningful action to ensure that every child feels heard, and experiences real safety, care and protection. Where we start our lives in terms of where we live, the resources available to us, and the opportunities presented to us make a significant difference to our life outcomes. While conversations can raise awareness, challenge harmful norms, and spark new ideas, real change happens when we take steps to create safer environments for children that prevent them from harm. The aim of NCPW is to bring together partners to focus on addressing the significant harms being experienced by children in Australia. By working collectively to change the trajectory of these children and families, we can reduce the number of children who may come in contact with the child protection system. The time to act is now. We are continuing to develop our policies and procedures as part of our commitment to Child Safety and NCPW assists us to achieve this commitment.

From today until Friday 19th September, our school is participating in Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools – School Improvement Surveys (MACSSIS). MACSSIS is an annual process whereby schools listen to the thoughts and feelings of students, families and staff have about how their school can improve. These surveys help inform the ongoing improvement of schools across the Archdiocese of Melbourne. You should have received an email today inviting you to complete the surveys which are completely anonymous.

I look forward to seeing you all at the Father's Day Breakfast this Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> September at 7.30am. We also look forward to the Father's Day Stall this Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> September.

# MACSSIS – Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools – School Improvement Surveys

Each year, St Paul's Primary School seeks feedback from our students, families, and staff to understand how our school is performing. This feedback is crucial for our progress and future planning.

In 2025, we will use the MACSSIS (Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools – School Improvement Surveys) to collect this feedback. Developed specifically for Catholic schools in Melbourne, MACSSIS is managed through a secure online platform by ORIMA Research Pty Ltd.

Students in Years 4 - 6 will complete the surveys during supervised sessions, while families and staff can access theirs using a secure link and password provided in an email. The survey can be completed over a three-week period beginning September 1st. September 19th 2025.

The feedback we receive will help guide our efforts to enhance our school. There are no 'right' or 'wrong' answers. All responses are completely anonymous and participation is completely voluntary. The survey is available in English, Arabic, Assyrian, Chaldean, simplified and traditional Chinese, Dinka, Hakha Chin, Karen, Tagalog, Vietnamese and Zomi.

Links and PINS for the survey will be emailed out to families **today**. If you do not receive yours, please email the office to have this re-sent. Please note that we send one survey per family.
