I congratulate the children on the way they have settled into school. They are striving ‘to be the best that they can be’! It is very different to kinder/child care – however, they are sitting quietly listening to their teachers.

I want to thank all our families with your flexibility last week with learning conversations. We were fairly certain there would be a lingering smell of smoke after the fire last Tuesday. However, when we arrived at school on Wednesday morning, the air had cleared so we made the decision to have the conversations in the classrooms as previously planned. I want to thank the staff for the way they promptly evacuated the building when we were made aware of the fire. I also want to thank the emergency services who arrived promptly and extinguished the fire. Thanks also to Joe and Hayden Micallef from Civis Electrical who came onsite to disconnect power to the damaged building and then reconnecting power and making the school safe when authorised by Fire Rescue Victoria. This incident was enough example of all in the St Paul's School Community when we were experiencing difficulties – thank you.

Our first assembly for 2026 will be on Friday, February 13th – we will be presenting the SRC for 2026. Please join us at 2.30pm.

There will be no school for children on April 1st and 2nd as staff will be preparing for the School Improvement Review and updating their First Aid skills. This will be the end of Term 1.

Enrolments for Prep 2027 are now open. This year, there is a change to the way we will accept enrolments. CANTEEN

ANAPHYLAXIS

There are several children at school who suffer from allergic reactions to various forms of food, plants, bites and stings. The Australian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy (ASCIA) does not recommend the banning of particular items. This is based on the premise that for school age children, an essential step is to develop strategies for avoidance in the wider community as well as at school. All staff have undertaken anaphylactic training and will have it renewed this term. The school has a thorough policy, action plan and procedures for each child, including first aid response and medication storage, to ensure the wellbeing of all students. BEFORE SCHOOL CARE
